Privacy Policy

This privacy policy is made on behalf of Capital Dynamics Sdn Bhd (Co. No. 171744-U) ("CDSB"). CDSB is committed to protecting your privacy and to compliance with the Personal Data Protection Act 2010 ("Act"). This privacy policy is formulated in accordance with the Act, which describes how your information is collected and used and your choices with respect to your Personal Data. The following discloses CDSB's information gathering and dissemination practices for this website, www.icapital.biz.

1. Information collected

Our Web servers do not automatically recognise specific information about individual users on our site. In addition, our servers do not automatically record information regarding a user's e-mail address unless the user supplies it.

We use and disclose aggregated non-personally identifying information collected through this Website as part of our organisation's process of constantly improving this Website and/or business.
